- Working in teams to research other ways to augment lake quality through:
 - Chemical
 - Mechanical weed harvesters(either we buy or rent),
 - Aeration to help remediate algae
 - Dredging to remove muck.
 (Lake Committee considers the pro/cons, costs, and other lakes that implemented any of these modes of lake cleanliness)
- Look for ways to help residents be aware of septic problems and preventative measures
- Control of goose poop through our addling program
- Stocking of fish
- Improvement of lake access at the beach and boat basins
- Lake cleanup days.


